Why Foundation?

Foundation courses are an increasingly popular way to enter into university degree programmes in the UK. A foundation programme offers several benefits for students, such as:



1

Providing students with a strong academic foundation which will help them succeed at university.

2

Developing essential study skills such as critical thinking, research, and analysis.

3

Increasing the chances of being accepted into a desired university programme.

4

Providing a pathway for students who are unsure about their desired career path, allowing them to explore different subjects and areas of interest.

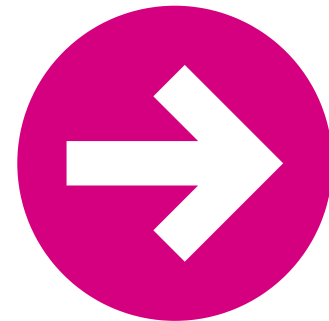
Foundation explained

They are courses designed specifically for international students to help them attain the right level of qualifications and skills they need to succeed at UK university degree level.

Typically available as an intensive two or three-semester programme of academic subjects, study skills and English language preparation.

The Foundation courses at OnCampus Southampton offer a range of proven and practical benefits for international students.

OnCampus

1: Designed for international students

International students face unique challenges when they get to UK universities. These courses are specifically designed to address the needs of students from all over the world. They're tailored to students to ensure that they are academically ready and personally confident enough to take on and succeed at an undergraduate course at a UK university.



2: Fills any gaps in knowledge between high school and university

Education standards differ around the globe, from state to state and country to country. Teaching methods differ, the number of study hours varies, and qualifications differ too. OnCampus Foundation courses are designed to level out the differences and get all students up to standard.



3: Academic classes combined with English language

For many international students, language is the most daunting aspect of studying abroad. While your academic record may be excellent, if you aren't used to studying or speaking in English every day, or your English language qualifications aren't up to speed, you may struggle on a degree course taught in English to native English speakers. OnCampus Foundation courses can help you prepare, by providing focused training in the kind of academic English that will help you in your future degree studies.





5: Get used to university-style teaching

As a graduate of a foundation course you'll have an advantage over students entering higher education straight from school. Foundation courses are taught using university-style teaching, often on-campus, with lectures, tutorials and seminar-style classes. This all helps prepare you better for your future university studies.

4: Specialise in your chosen field

On a foundation course you can tailor your course to suit the degree programme you wish to study for in future. OnCampus Southampton offers two distinct foundation programmes. They involve studying core modules common to each route, plus a set of subject-specific modules that are carefully designed to focus on the academic areas most useful to your chosen degree.



6: Time to adjust

Arriving at the place you want to study, two to three semesters before you begin your full degree programme, gives you plenty of time to settle into everyday life, not just academic life. It means you have time to make friends, soak up those cultural differences and practical things like finding your way around town. It puts you in touch with other students who are experiencing just the same fear and excitement as you, ensuring you're on a firm foundation when you begin your undergraduate course.



7: A guaranteed university place

You are issued a conditional university offer, alongside your OnCampus offer of a place and once you complete your foundation course and achieve the required grades, you'll be guaranteed entry into the first year of your chosen undergraduate degree at the University of Southampton.

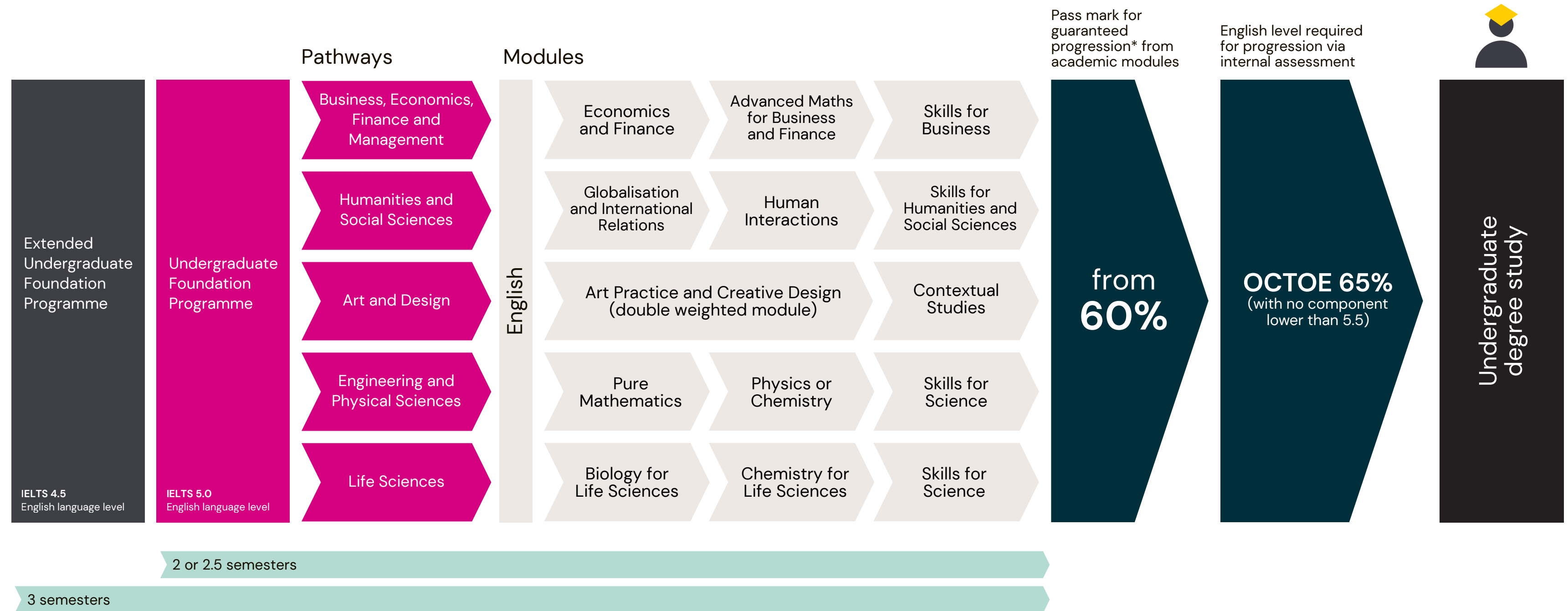

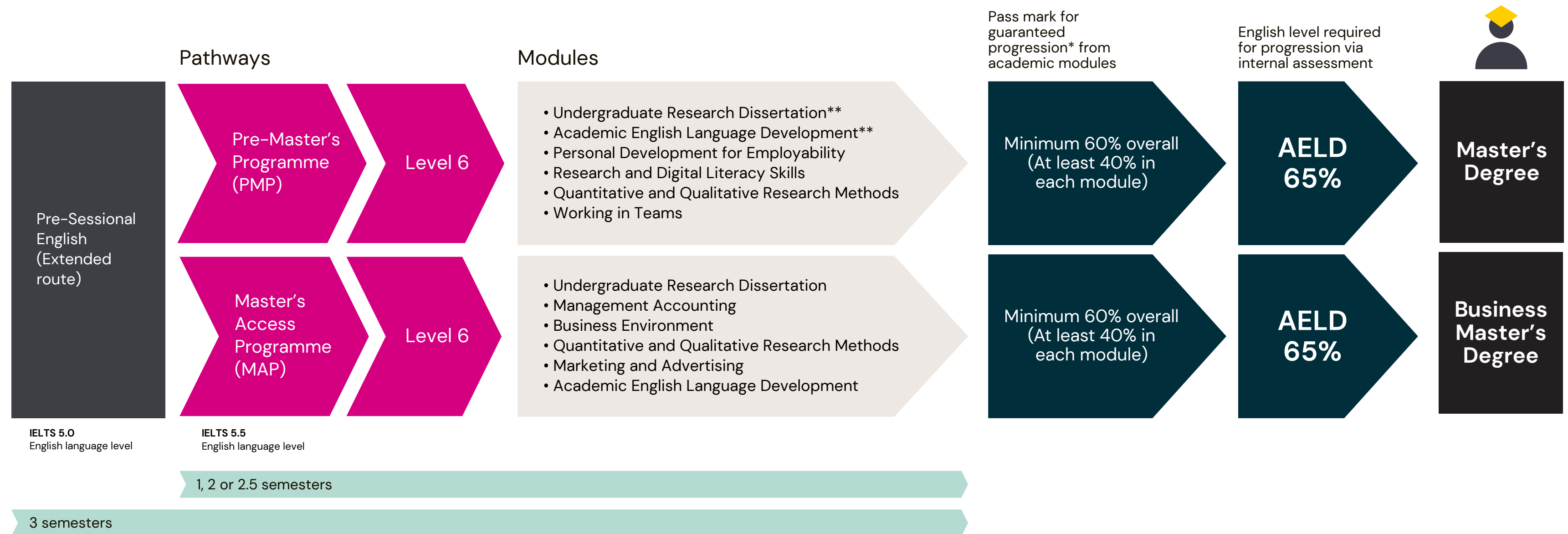

Merit Scholarships

Merit scholarships are available for OnCampus Southampton students who successfully progress on to select degrees at the university.

Scholarships are offered **up to £3,000** from the first year of tuition fee at undergraduate level and **up to £9,000** for postgraduate level.

They are awarded automatically to students who meet the eligibility criteria.
