## Age

- International Foundation Programme: Applicants must normally be 17 years old.

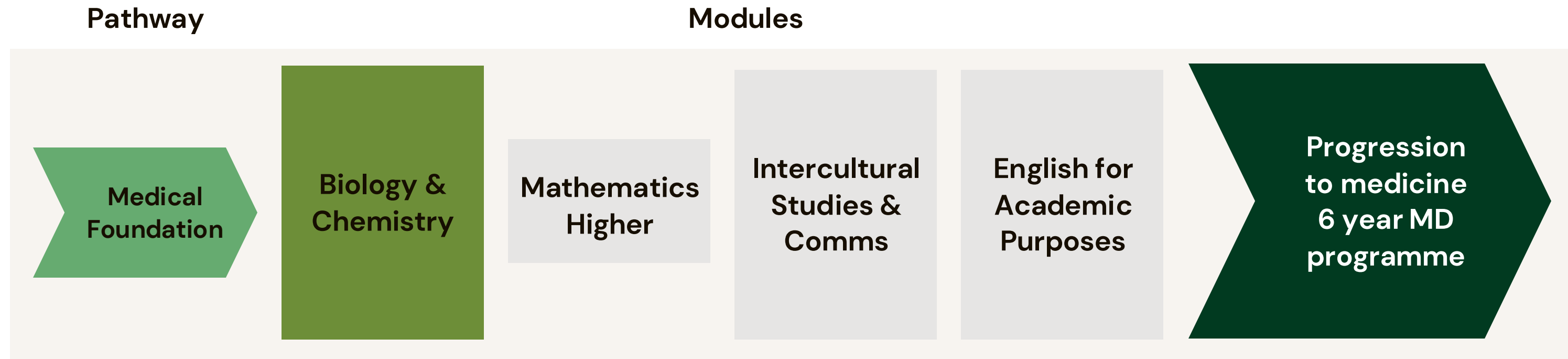
## Academic

- Applicants must hold a certificate of secondary education at GCSE level or equivalent to include a
- minimum pass grade in maths and a minimum pass grade in four other subjects.
- Admission in specialty Medicine is based on the secondary school leaving certificate achievements in Biology and Chemistry (minimum requirement is 62% as average result in both subjects).
- IELTS 6.5 overall with no component less than 6.0 in the written, listening, speaking, and reading.

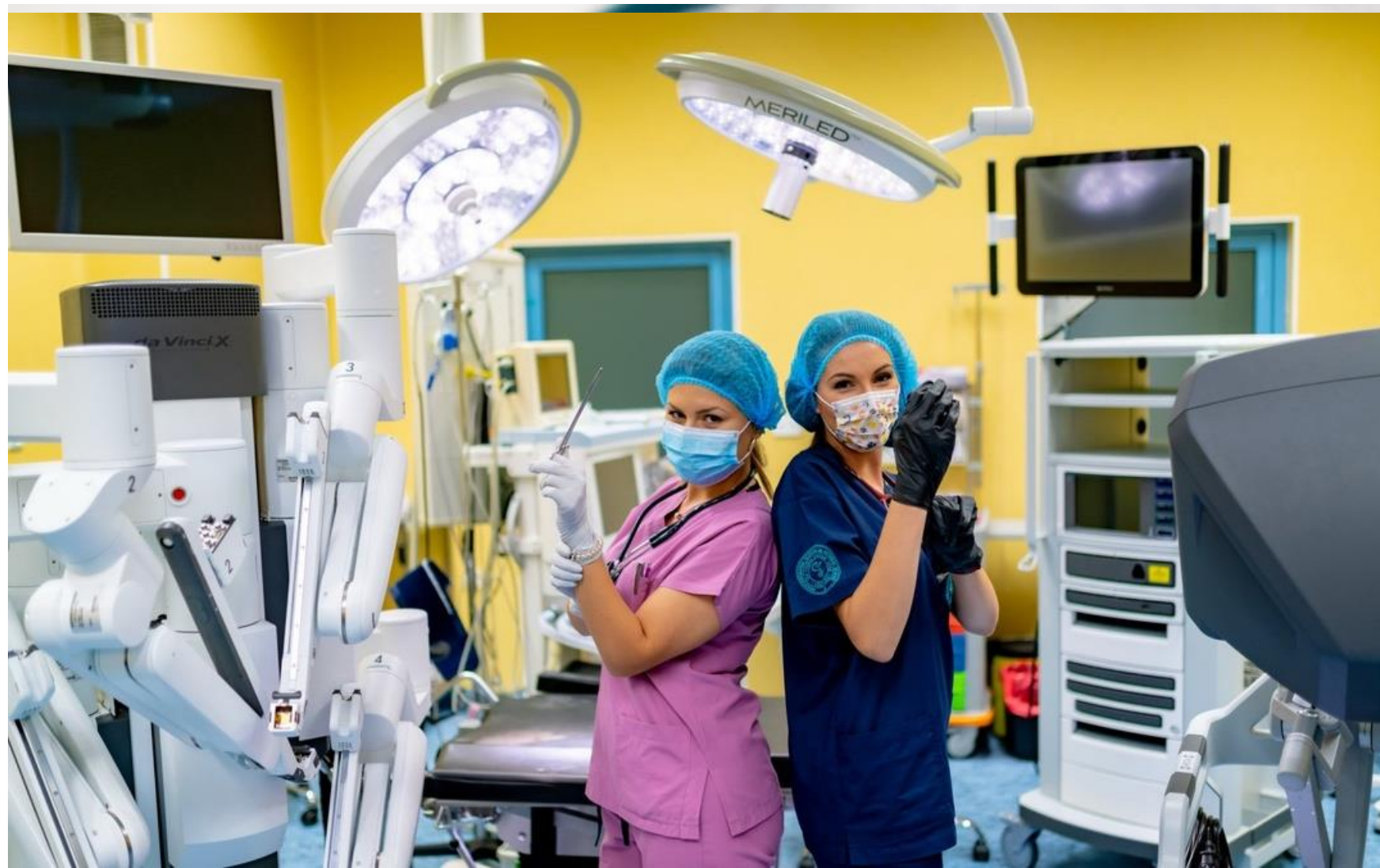
## **First 2 years – Pre-clinical training Subjects include:**

Full 6-year MD programme entirely in English, designed specifically for international students.

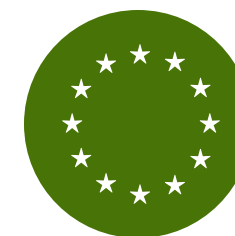
No need to speak Bulgarian to complete your degree, though you will learn basic Bulgarian for clinical communication.



## Affordable Tuition

Tuition €8,500 per year, which is significantly lower than in Western Europe or North America.

Living costs in Pleven are also low – many students live comfortably on €300–€500 per month.
