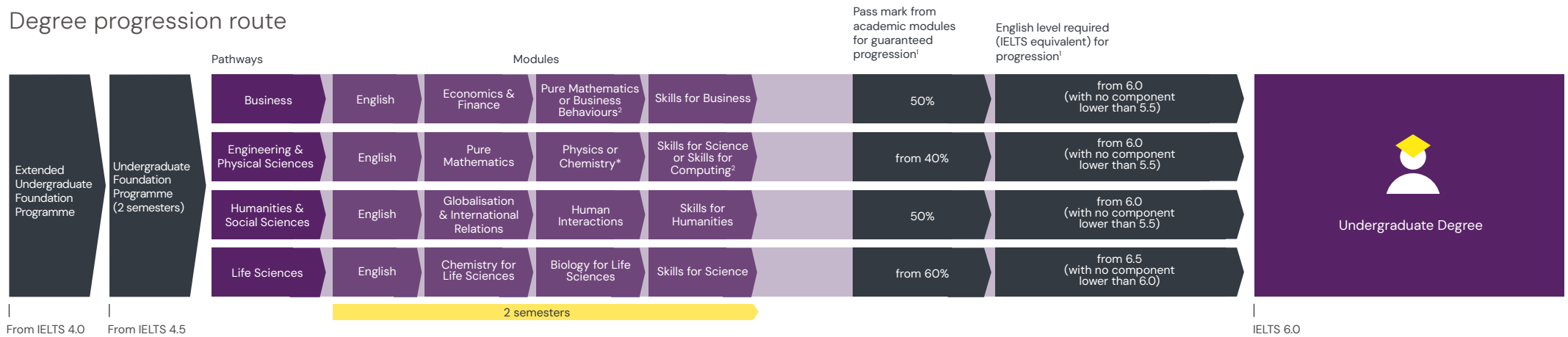

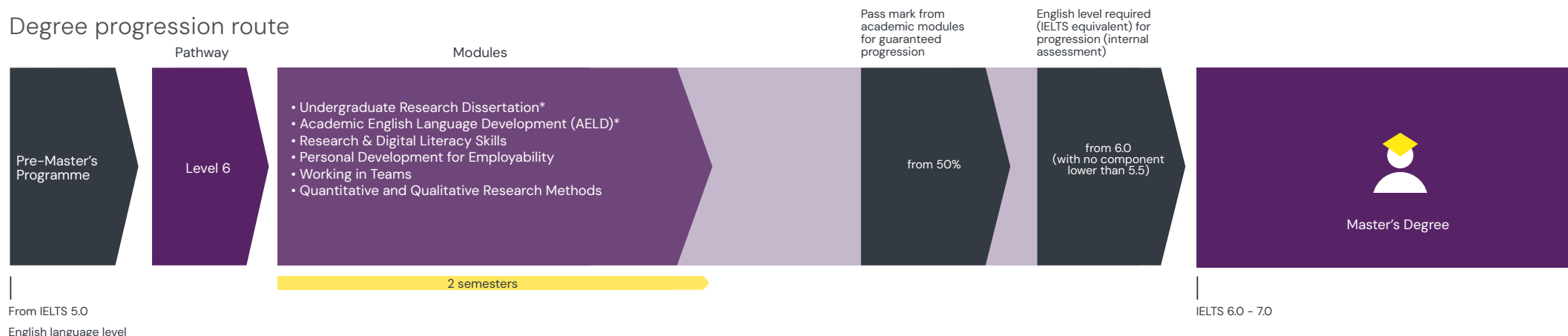

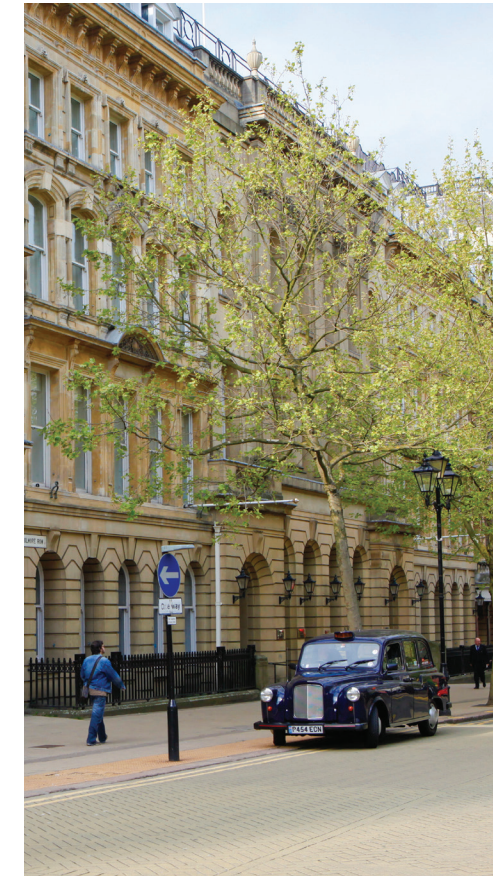


## Diversity
