

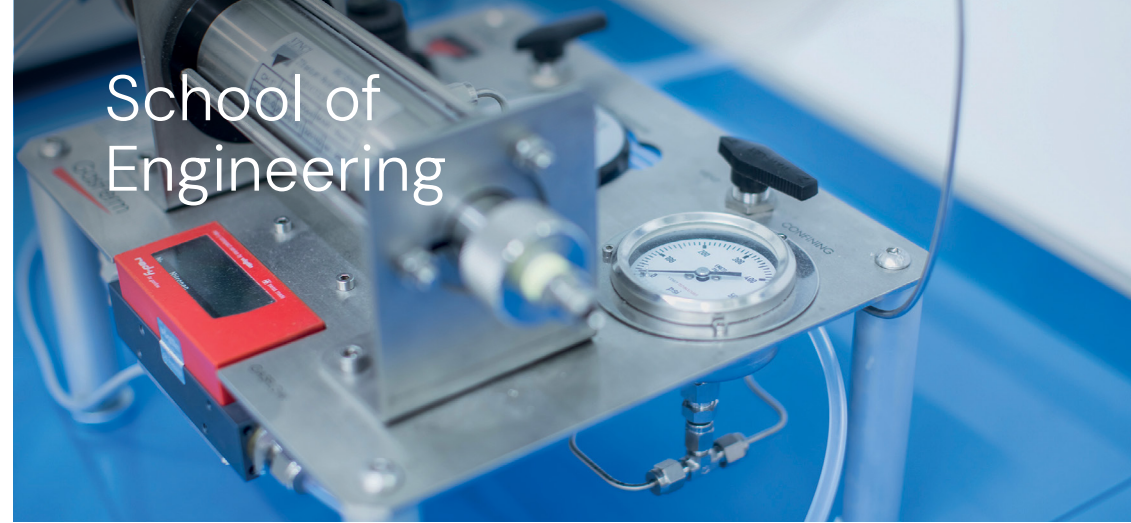

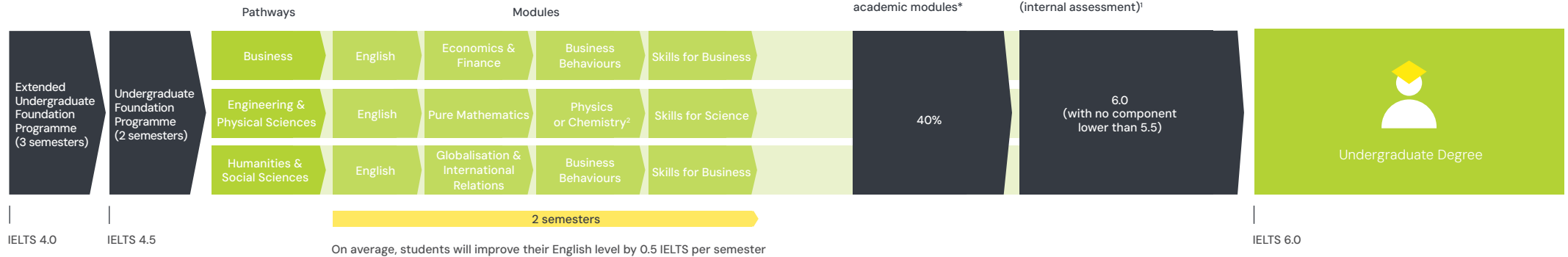

**English level:**  
From 4.5 IELTS or equivalent, with no component less than 4.5, for 2-semester UFP. An Extended programme is available if you do not have the required English language level. This programme includes an English language module followed by 2 semesters of UFP.

**Academic Requirements:**

<sup>2</sup> You can progress to Life Sciences degrees by studying Chemistry on the Engineering pathway.

### 11–12 years

17+

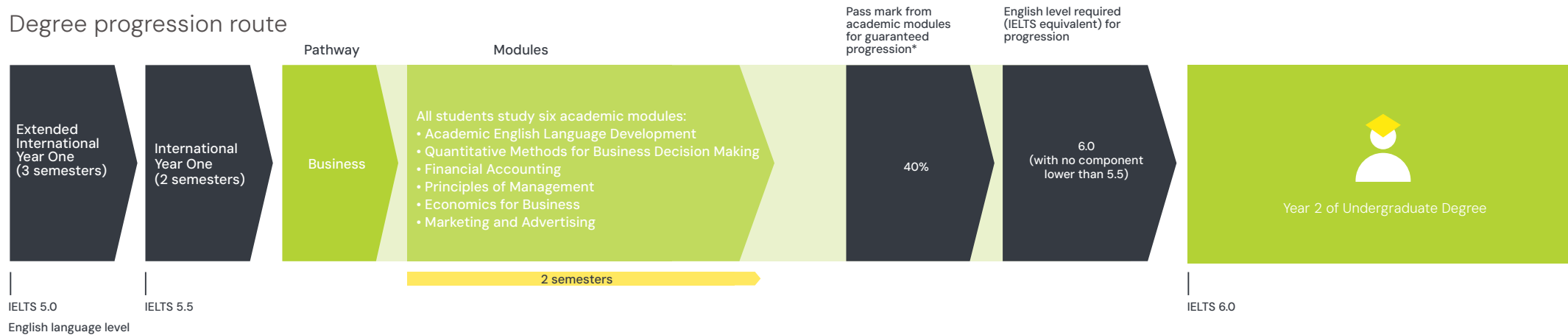


# International Year One (IY1)

## Entry Criteria

### English level:

From 5.5 IELTS

Minimum 5.5 IELTS or equivalent, with no single element less than 5.0, for 2-semester IY1.

An Extended programme is available if you do not have the required English language level. This programme includes an English language module (ELPP) followed by 2 semesters of IY1.

### Academic Requirements:

12 years

Successful completion of high school with good grades. Please see [oncampus.global](http://oncampus.global) for country-specific academic entry requirements.

### Guideline Minimum Age:

17+

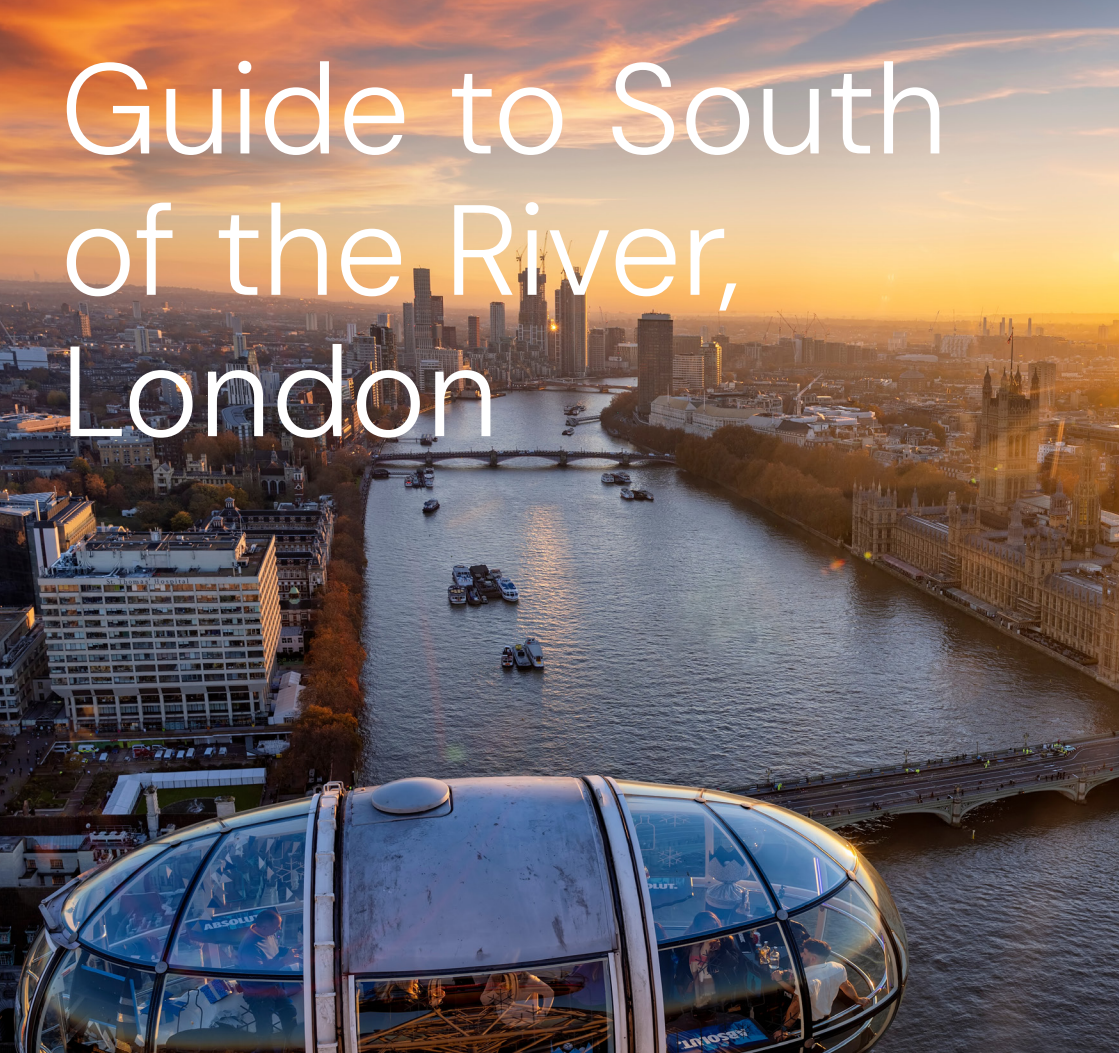
