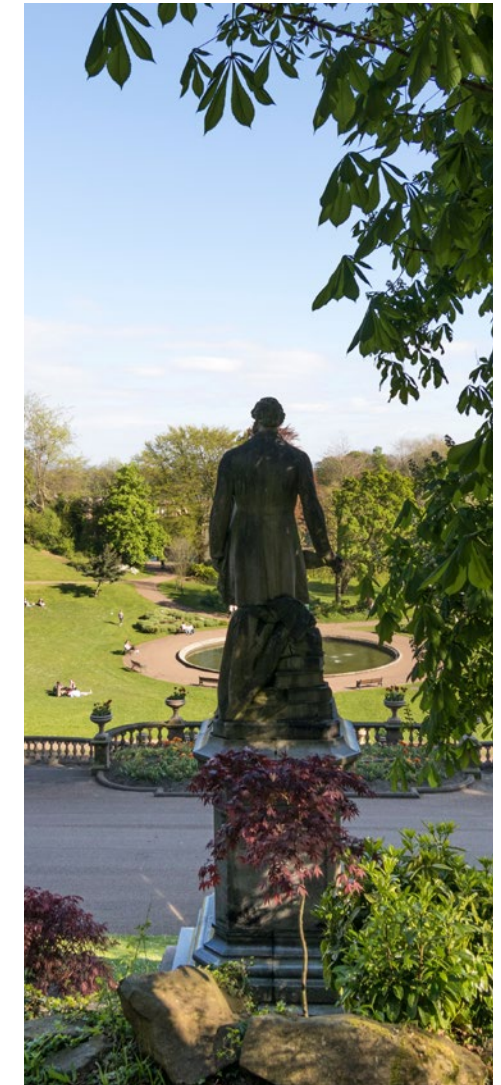
Purple Flag Status

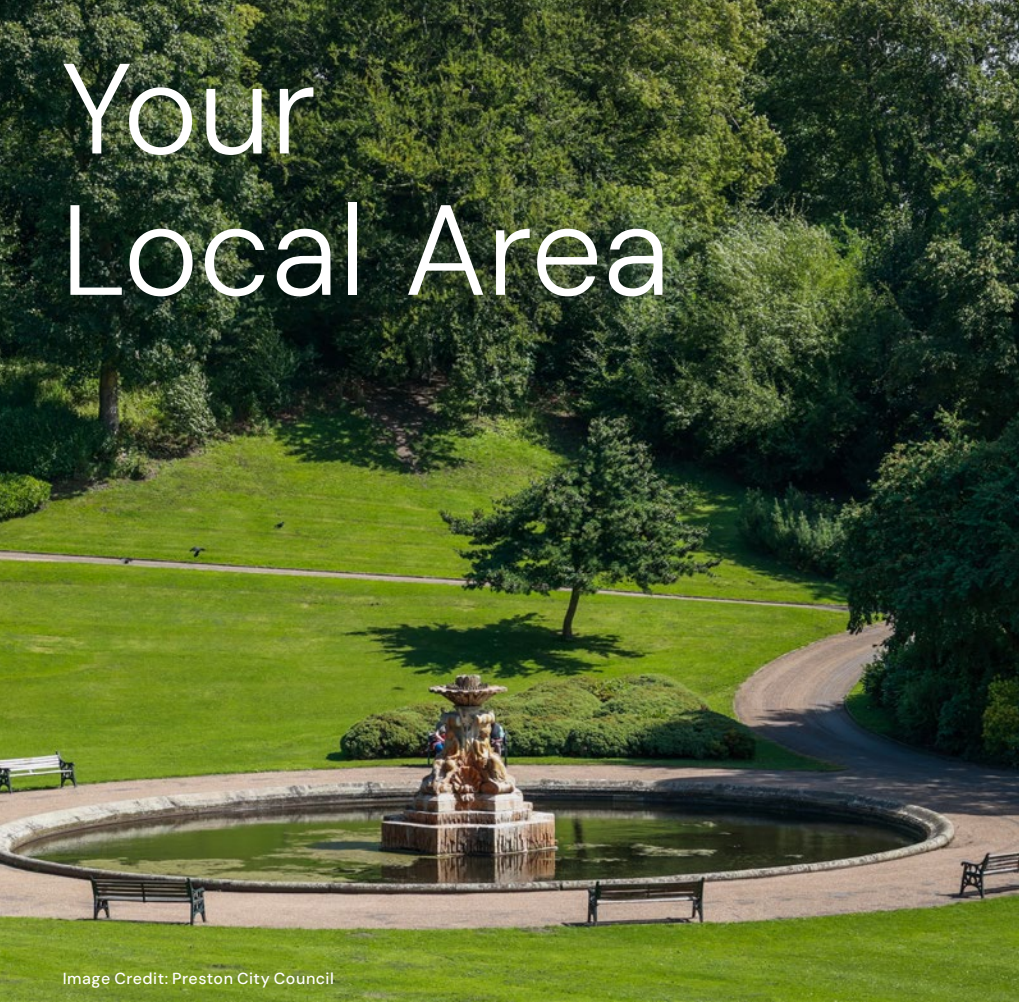
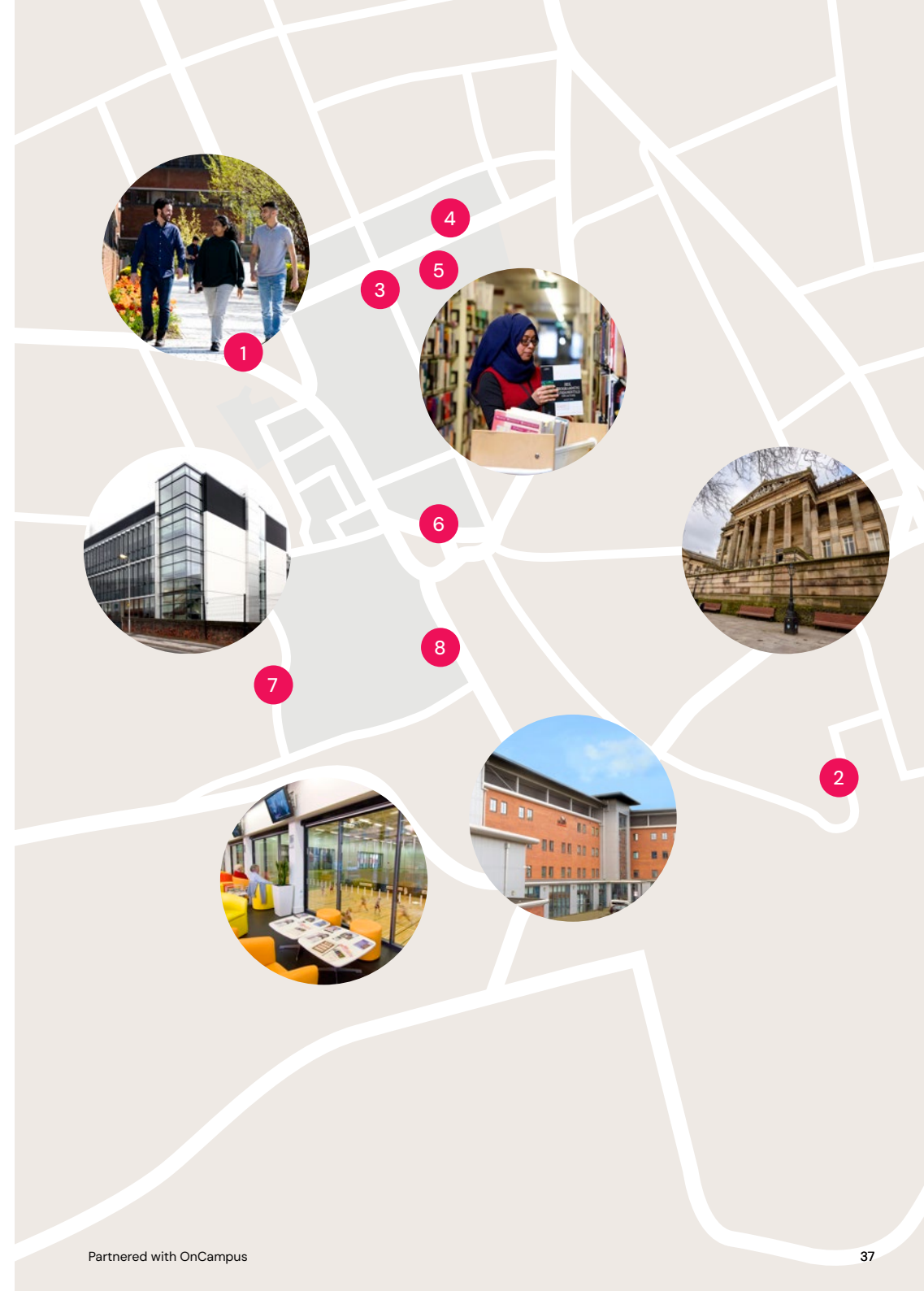
